

Academic Quality Assurance: Annual process

Program and course thresholds 2024

For 2024 Annual Academic Quality Assurance process the following University-wide minimum thresholds are applied **to 2022 and 2023 data**. The Associate Deans Academic can impose higher thresholds in the context of their faculty.

Performance	Average GPA	Not set centrally – Faculties to look for outliers at either end of the GPA distribution
	Progress rate	Not set centrally – Faculties to look for outliers at lower end of progression rate distribution
Retention	% retained at UQ after 1 st year, domestic cohort (UQ 3yr+ programs + MD)	<80% (at least 20 commencements)
		Faculties should also consider outliers in the context of their faculty
	% retained at UQ after 1 st year, international cohort (UQ 3yr+ programs + MD)	<90% (at least 10 commencements)
		Faculties should also consider outliers in the context of their faculty
Graduate outcomes	% in full-time employment, domestic cohort	<60% (at least 30 respondents)

	% in further full-time studies, domestic cohort	Not set centrally
Satisfaction	% satisfied with quality of overall educational experience	<65% (at least 30 respondents)

Performance	Pass rate	<70% (at least 20 enrolments)
		Faculties should also consider outliers in the context of their faculty
Attrition	% withdrawn before census	Not set centrally – Faculties may wish the review the data and identify courses with an ongoing issue around attrition
Satisfaction	Mean response for SECaT question 8	<3.5 (at least 6 respondents)
		Faculties may wish to set a higher threshold and/or consider courses that are above the threshold for Q8 but below 3.5 on other questions
Demand	Enrolments	Not set centrally – Faculties to use data to provide an overall response (a memorandum outside of the online response system) around how they are managing courses with small enrolment numbers or courses with revenue that does not cover the costs
Sustainability	Course revenue-to- cost ratio
