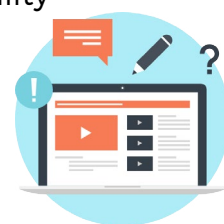

### My favourite teaching tools

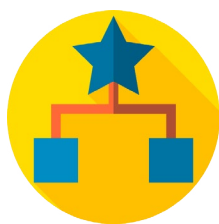
My favourite teaching tools are sites and resources that inspire quality approaches to learning and teaching. I'm a fan of:
