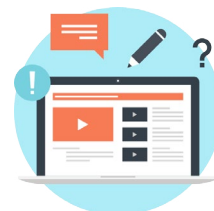

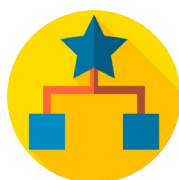

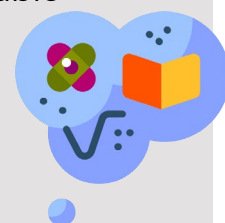

Memorable teaching moment

Although I have had many memorable teaching moments, one that stands out clearly is the semester that I designed and facilitated an ethics seminar for postgraduate students. The class included many international students who had never formally studied ethical decision-making before, and these students appeared especially apprehensive and nervous in the first seminar.



It was so gratifying watching these students start thinking more critically and engaging with the learning material over the course of the semester. In particular, their reflective essays submitted at the end of the semester indicated that the discussions, case analyses and practical exercises in class had encouraged them to think more deeply about ethical issues and challenged them to examine their decision-making and behaviour in new ways.
