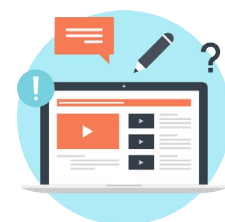

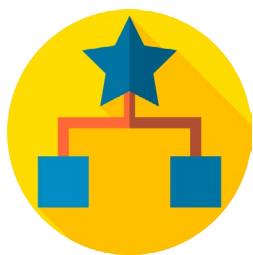
### My favourite teaching tools

Having a complete mental freeze regarding the answer to a particularly complex problem I'd included in the lecture notes!
