The GOS-L instrument focuses on measuring the following: · labour force history · further study · graduate attributes, and · graduate preparation. GOS-L participation is open to any higher education institution that took part in the AGS (2013-2015), and subsequently, rounds of the GOS. <b>Employer Satisfaction Survey (ESS)</b> - all employment supervisors of GOS graduates are in-scope for the ESS.	2015	Data is collected through an online platform.
